Hot spots

- Though life has returned to normal in much of China, officials are scrambling to control a coronavirus outbreak centered around the northern city of Harbin.
- **Haiti**, with 58 cases and four deaths, is worried about laid-off Haitian workers returning from the **Dominican Republic** (5,300 cases and 260 deaths) and bringing the virus with them.
- Eight infants and toddlers at a residential care center in **Tokyo** have tested positive for the coronavirus, raising concerns about a wider outbreak at facilities for neglected or abused children.
- The U.N. has confirmed the first known case in a **Palestinian refugee camp** in **Lebanon**, intensifying fears that the virus will tear through one of the Middle East's most vulnerable populations.
